## Bridges Charter School Student Transportation Policy

### *Ineligible Notice*

The safe operation of Motor Vehicles is imperative to the safety of our employees, volunteers and students as well as the public.

The management of our Charter school has reviewed your Motor Vehicle Record and determined you are ineligible to drive on Bridges behalf.

If you disagree with the information provided, you have been given the opportunity to go to DMV within 30 days of notification, correct the information and give us an updated/corrected copy of your Motor Vehicle Record.

The information contained in your Motor Vehicle Record is of concern to our Charter school with respect to your ability to drive safely.

Any employee or volunteer who has accumulated moving violations, accidents or a combination thereof that exceeds the standards aforementioned in this policy is subject to ineligibility of Charter school driving privileges. Immediate suspension of Charter school driving privileges also applies should the State revoke or suspend the driver's license.

You have the opportunity to go to DMV within 30 days of this notification and correct the information, and give us an updated/corrected copy of your Motor Vehicle Record. In the event that you are unable to correct the deficiencies that prompted your Charter school driving ineligibility, your status will remain in effect.
